Tools to Make Caring Easier



If you care for someone who needs your help, **there is equipment to support you.**

This equipment can make caring **easier and safer.**



We can give equipment to carers for free **who can't afford it themselves.**

It has to be over £50.



This is the equipment we're able to offer to carers:



Communication Aids:



Amazon Echo Dot.

This can help you **keep in contact with your family** or **remind you to take medication.**



Large Photo Button Phone

These phones can help **people with dementia.**



Call Pendant with Plug in Alarm

When the button is pressed, it sets off an alarm. This helps you know **when the person you care for needs help.**

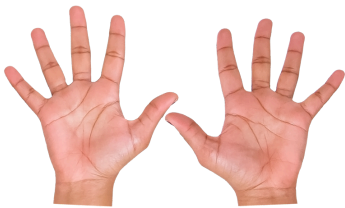


Monitoring Aids:



Care Monitor

This helps you to **see and speak to a person in another room.**



Physical and Mobility Aids:



Handy Bar

Helpful for people to get **in and out of their car.**



Over Bed Table

You can put this over a chair or a bed. **It makes it easier to eat** if someone finds it hard to move.



Automatic Medication Tipping Pot

This helps people who may not be strong enough to open their medication on their own.



Security Aids:



Key Safe:

This means you can keep your keys somewhere safe outside of your house. You can keep spare keys here for emergencies.



Video Doorbell:

See, hear, and speak to visitors via your connected phone or tablet.



Fall Prevention Aids:



LED Motion Sensor Night Light:

Lights activate when someone passes, preventing falls in the dark.



Plug In Torch

The torch lights up during power cuts and when you walk past it for safety.



Memory Aids:



Large Medication Dispenser:

The dispenser alarms **6 times daily**, has **28 compartments**, and **locks** to ensure access only at scheduled times.



Small Medication Dispenser:

Device beeps **4 times daily** for medication, **fewer compartments** than Large Dispenser.



Day and Night Clock:

This is a very **simple clock**. It has images to help people read the time.



Digital Calendar Clock:

Clock helps those with **dementia** or **visual impairments** by showing time or date.



Magi Plug:

This prevents **sinks from flooding**. It can also stop someone from being **burnt**.

Object Locator:



You can **stick this onto items that you often lose**.

It will make a beeping noise and help you find the item quicker.



Eating and Drinking Aids:



Hot Water Dispenser:

This device boils **one cup of water at a time**. This means you only boil what you need.
