



Group Assistant Volunteer – Lancing

We are looking for a **Group Assistant Volunteer** to support our monthly **Lancing Open to All Carer Group**. In this role, you will help welcome carers to the group, support the smooth running of sessions, and support the Carer Wellbeing Worker to create a safe and friendly space for people to connect.

Frequency:	The first Tuesday of the month. 1.30 – 4.pm (Includes brief/ debrief)
Commitment:	Monthly
Trial or shadowing available before applying	

Role Expectations

In this role, you will work alongside the Carer Wellbeing Worker to help provide a safe, welcoming and supportive space for carers. The group meets monthly in person and gives carers the opportunity to connect with others who understand similar experiences, share information and receive peer support. This group is for people who care for anyone regardless of condition, so open to all, and aims to support carers through their caring journey.

Key tasks will be:

- Welcome carers to the group and help create a friendly, supportive atmosphere.
- Prepare and serve refreshments, helping carers feel comfortable and settled.
- Support the Carer Wellbeing Worker with the smooth running of each session.
- Encourage participation and support smaller group discussions where needed.
- Help welcome and support guest speakers, assisting with session activities as required.
- Share agreed information and signpost carers to relevant support where appropriate.
- Report any concerns raised during the group to staff, following safeguarding and confidentiality guidance.

What Difference Will You Make?

Your support will help create a welcoming space where carers can take a break, connect with others who understand their experiences, and feel less alone. By helping the group run smoothly, you will enable carers to access peer support, useful information and opportunities to improve their wellbeing.

Skills and Attributes Required

- Good listening and communication skills.
- Ability to help carers feel welcome, included and supported in a group setting.
- Confidence engaging with people and supporting discussions where needed.
- Understanding of the challenges carers may face.
- Empathetic, respectful and non-judgemental approach.
- Ability to maintain boundaries, confidentiality and follow safeguarding guidance.
- Willingness to help with practical tasks, such as preparing refreshments and setting up the meeting space.

Locations, Timings, and Commitment

This role is based at Lancing Parish Hall, 96 South Street, Lancing, West Sussex, BN15 8AJ.

The group meets on the first Tuesday of each month from 1.45pm to 3.45pm. Volunteers are asked to support the group monthly and, where possible, commit to the role for at least six months.

Upcoming meeting dates are 4 August, 1 September, 6 October and 18 November.

Training and Support

You will receive training and support to help you feel confident in the role, including:

- A volunteer induction
- A role specific orientation.
- Safeguarding and Data Protection training
- A dedicated Volunteer Mentor who will support you throughout your volunteering journey
- Access to additional training opportunities relevant to your role and areas of interest across our services
- Opportunities to develop your confidence, communication and group facilitation skills.

Equipment Needed

- A computer, laptop or tablet that can be used for online training.
- Access to the Volunteer app to manage volunteering information and communication.

Additional information

- This role is open to volunteers aged 18 and over.
- A basic DBS check is required for this role.
